This week we learned that a third member of our community has tested positive for COVID-19. Because of the Christmas break and the remote learning days that preceded it, the person who has tested positive was not on campus during the contagious period, and therefore contact-tracing is not required. We also believe it is worth noting that none of the three cases we have reported over the past month are related to one another, nor do we believe that any of these cases was contracted on our campus.
