Today we learned that a fourth member of our community has tested positive for COVID-19. The person who has tested positive has not been on campus since before the Christmas break, and therefore we will not need to do any large-scale contact-tracing. We are writing merely to inform you of this case in the spirit of transparency. Once again we believe it is worth noting that none of the cases we have reported over the past months are related to one another, nor do we believe that any of these cases was contracted on our campus.

We would ask you to join us not only in your continued diligence to protect our community from exposure to this virus, but also in prayer for the individuals and families whose lives have been impacted by COVID-19. We pray for healthcare and frontline workers, the poor and the vulnerable, and on this Feast of the Epiphany, we pray for God's light to illumine the darkness of these challenging times.
