Dear Cheverus Community,

I'm writing to update you on our contact-tracing process and our remote learning schedule moving forward. Last night we learned that a 2nd person in our community has tested positive for COVID-19, and this 2nd case was also on campus less than 48 hours prior to the onset of symptoms. Our contact-tracing process this morning has identified that over one quarter of our students and teaching faculty had contact with these two individuals; members of our administration have begun calling the families of all these students, and we appreciate your patience as we complete this process. Once all families have been notified we will email the community again - hopefully later today.

Due to the extent of the contact, we will shift to a remote learning schedule through Thursday, March 25. All co-curriculars and athletics are also cancelled during this time period. We do not make this decision lightly, and we realize this will come as a disappointment to our community; nonetheless, we feel it is necessary to assure the safety of our students and consistency of our classes over the next two weeks.

In-person classes will resume on Friday, March 26. We will also move the end of the third quarter (originally March 26) back to accommodate some in-person classes before the end of the quarter; there will be more details to follow regarding the end of quarter and our schedule once we return. On this one year anniversary of our first remote learning day last spring, today's news is a reminder of the importance of remaining vigilant to protect our community from exposure to COVID-19.
